<b>Abstract Submittals Must Include:</b>	<b>Requirements for Presentation:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Your name, title, organization, mailing address, phone number, email address and session title</i></li> <li>• <i>Names of all speakers, and a short paragraph about each speaker, suitable for use as an introduction</i></li> <li>• <i>Indicate session format (lecture, panel, other)</i></li> <li>• <i>Total time needed for presentation (minimum time 50 minutes)</i></li> <li>• <i>Description of session objectives and goals</i></li> <li>• <i>Target Audience</i></li> <li>• <i>Abstract of 100 to 150 words</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Session title must be identical to the title of the abstract</i></li> <li>• <i>Overt selling of products or consulting services is not acceptable</i></li> <li>• <i>A copy of the presentation must be submitted no later than July 1.</i></li> <li>• <i>The presentation must be reflective of the abstract as submitted and accepted</i></li> <li>• <i>At least one of the authors must attend the Annual Conference and present the presentation</i></li> </ul>
